Descendants of victims of Nazi persecution: Agents in a changing national and international culture of remembrance

The focus of the fifth forum "Future of Remembrance" is the perspective of the heterogeneous group of the victims' children and grandchildren on the development of the national and international culture of remembrance. Panel discussions and workshops will be dealing with the issues of children's and grandchildren's psychosocial needs, the role they play in the historical and political education as well as in dialogue projects between children and grandchildren of victims of persecution and those of perpetrators. The forum offers the families, members of survivors' associations, employees of the Neuengamme Concentration Camp Memorial and affiliated organizations as well as young people and everyone else interested the possibility to discuss the future of commemoration.

The event will be simultaneously translated into German, English and Polish.
