We reserve the right to take down any contributions likely to impede or inhibit constructive dialogue, infringe personal rights, or are racist, antisemitic, sexist, extremist, discriminatory, insulting or pornographic in tone or content.

Misuse and copyright

Our social media channels are not advertising spaces for other websites or services. Commercial contributions and advertising by third parties are not permitted as a matter of principle. Please also ensure that you have the copyright to any images you post online.

Violation of commenting rules

By interacting on our social media channels you implicitly accept our rules. All users take sole responsibility for their contributions. Nevertheless, we reserve the right to take down and report contributions and, if necessary, block their author(s) if said contributions do not comply with our rules.
